

Dear Horse Owner,

Thank you for your interest in having your horse trained during our upcoming Show.

We encourage all interested horse owners to submit an application. The horse can be any gender, color or breed (with the exception of ponies). It must measure at least 14.2 hands but be no more than 16 hands in height. It is not required that the horse is shod, but the hooves should be properly trimmed to prevent undue stress on tendons, ligaments, etc.

If possible, protective boots made by Professional's Choice will be used on your horse's legs while working in the round pen. The boots may be available for purchase at a discounted price after the Show.

It is your responsibility to get your horse to the Show. You must arrive at least two hour before the time your horse is to be worked unless special arrangements have been made with the office. You should bring everything needed to care for your horse: feed, hay, bedding, buckets, halter, lead rope, etc. You will be responsible for the feeding, handling, and care of your horse, except while it is being trained in the round pen.

A negative coggins test and a current health certificate must be presented upon arrival at the facility.

The training fee for an unbroken horse is \$300.00, for a "problem" horse, the fee is \$200.00. If you are submitting an application for a "problem" horse, **you must be willing to ride the horse before John begins training**. Both fees include admittance for one to the show your horse will be used in. The fee must be paid prior to the Show.

You will be responsible for all costs rendered by the facility in connection with your horse. Please contact the facility directly to make these arrangements. (Fees usually average \$15.00 per night but vary according to the facility).

An application is attached to this letter. Please fill it out and return it to us at your earliest convenience. Submitting an application is in no way a guarantee that your horse will be selected. You will be notified if it is chosen. Thank you for your interest. I am looking forward to hearing from you.
